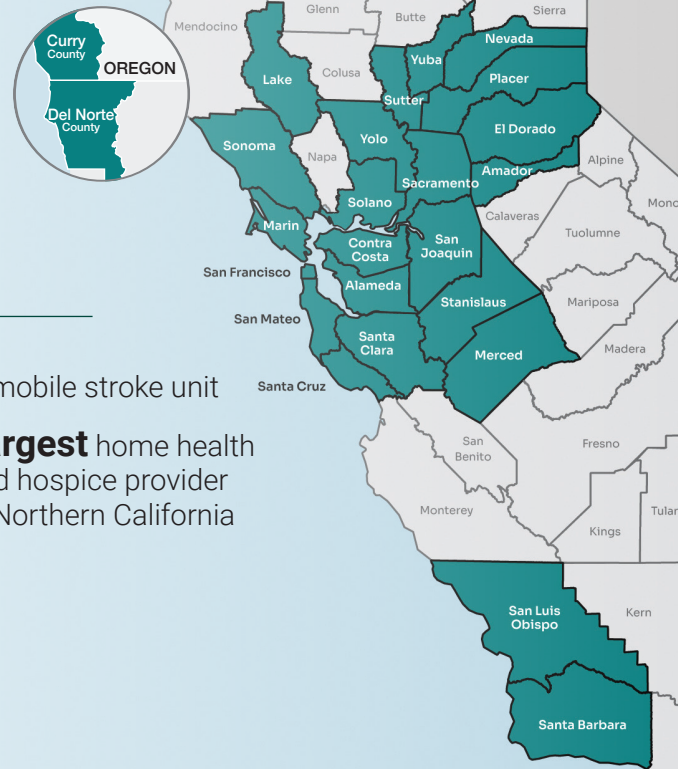

Training the Next Generation of Healthcare Professionals

Sutter is heavily investing in physician residency, nurse training, and allied healthcare professional development programs to cultivate more clinical talent to address a growing shortage of healthcare professionals.

- **GME Growth:** On track to train **575 physician residents and fellows** across 39 accredited graduate medical education programs by the end of 2027.
- **Academic Partnerships:** Robust partnerships expand training and career pathways—including a 10-year collaboration with Charles R. Drew University of Medicine and Science, one of four historically Black medical schools in the country, to fund **50 full scholarships**, and the NextGen Scholars program with California community colleges, creating healthcare career pathways for 5,000 high school students by 2030.

Closing Healthcare Gaps by Expanding Access

- **Care Capacity:** More than 2,000 new physicians and clinicians recruited over the past three years to expand access to care.
- **System Growth:** 45 new centers opened since 2023, with dozens more planned in the coming years.
- **Community Impact Investments:** nearly \$1.2 billion invested last year in community benefit programs, including charity care, unreimbursed Medi-Cal costs, and targeted partnerships that support vulnerable populations and overall community health.

Game-changing Projects

- **Emeryville Campus:** A new flagship hospital opening by 2033, alongside an outpatient care complex launching by 2028, will deliver advanced specialty and primary care — transforming healthcare across the East Bay.
- **Sutter Advanced Neuroscience Complex:** Opening in 2028, the new complex will serve as an advanced regional hub for neurological care, bringing specialty services, ambulatory surgery, diagnostics, and research together under one roof at Mission Bernal in San Francisco.
- **Santa Clara Campuses:** A new state-of-the-art hospital opening in 2032 will anchor one of two developing campuses, featuring centers of excellence in primary care, women’s health, pediatrics, cardiac, orthopedic, and cancer care.
- **Modesto Cancer Center:** Opening in 2029 at Sutter’s Memorial Medical Center, this four-story, 165,000-square-foot facility will expand access to innovative, comprehensive cancer and surgical care across the Central Valley.

Driving Clinical Advancement

- Sutter invests heavily in research and clinical trials to pioneer healthcare breakthroughs, with **7,650 patients enrolled in 530 clinical trials**.
- **Strategic investments in digital health, AI and our Innovation Center** are making our care more accessible, impactful, efficient and convenient for patients and care teams.
- **\$350M invested this year** in new clinical technology is enhancing our ability to provide the best possible patient outcomes.
- **Building a vast array of new facilities** — including new hospitals and advanced specialty care centers — to bring care closer to home for our patients.

Driving Economic Impact

- **\$8.8B invested** in 2025 in total employee compensation, including competitive wages and benefits.
- **142,000 jobs** created — at Sutter Health, its suppliers and at other businesses supported by household spend⁴.
- Nearly **\$4B** in capital investments to support new construction or modernization of medical centers and facilities since 2022.
